**WARM UPS:** 8:00 a.m. to 8:55 a.m.

**START TIME:** 9:00 a.m. (expected end time is no later than 12:00 noon)

**ELIGIBILITY:**

Novice, pre-competitive level swimmers, working towards Regional time Standards

**NOTE:** Pre-competitive swimmers must be registered with Swim Ontario and will swim as exhibition only. These swimmers are limited to compete once during the swim season as per Swim Ontario guidelines.

**ENTRY LIMITATIONS:**

Each swimmer is limited to one distance per stroke and a maximum of **5 events** plus relay.

Entries limited to swimmers that have not achieved a Provincial Level C time in the requested event.

**ENTRY FEES:**

For Brantford and Hamilton swimmers: **\$7.00 per swimmer.**

Cheques should be made payable to **Hamilton Aquatic Club.**

**ENTRIES:**

- No entries will be accepted directly; all entries must be submitted via [www.swimming.ca](http://www.swimming.ca)
- Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet manager.
- Dates of birth and valid SNC numbers are mandatory for each swimmer.
- Receipt confirmation of your entries will be sent via e-mail.

**ENTRY DEADLINES:** Entries must be received by Friday **November 18, 2016**. Entries received after this date will still be accepted at the discretion of the meet manager. The scratch deadline is Tuesday **November 22, 2016**. There is no additional penalty for scratching after the deadline, but entry fees are still due for the swimmers that scratch after the deadline.

**MEET FORMAT/RULES:**

- All events are timed finals, seeded fastest to slowest.
- Events will be multi-seeded, with mixed ages.
- The host seeks an exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events due to facility or time limitations, swimming separated by gender would not permit all swims to be completed while offering reasonable opportunities to swim for all participants, and in particular on an equitable basis for swimmers of each gender.
- The results will be posted by the age groups listed below.
- There are no pre-requisite times as this is a Novice meet where swimmers are attempting some races for the first time.
- No session will be longer than 4.5 hours
- Meet Management requires that any coach wishing to rely on a time achieved by the swimmer for an interval shorter than the total distance of the event shall so advise the Referee prior to the commencement of the session (or event) in question.

**RECORDING OF AN EVENT:**

- Only individuals that have made application and received authorization to record the event, in any manner, in any medium or context known or unknown or hereafter developed, shall be granted access and permission to do so. Please contact meet management for application and authorization.

**COACH'S REGISTRATION:**

Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches in attendance at this competition with the [Swim Ontario Compliancy lists](#). If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the SNC policy and not permit that coach to attend meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.

**SAFETY & LIABILITY:** Only participating swimmers, officials, certified registered coaches, and authorized people are allowed on deck.

**AGE GROUPINGS:**

BOYS: 8&Under, 9&10, 11&12, 13&Over.

GIRLS: 8&Under, 9&10, 11&12, 13&Over.

Age for this competition is based on age as of the first day of competition.

**MEET RESULTS:**

Results will be forwarded to [www.swimming.ca](http://www.swimming.ca) within 48 hours of the completion of the meet.

**MEET AWARDS:** Best Time Ribbons will be given to each swimmer for every event where a new best time is achieved. A "NT" entry with a finish time will receive a best time ribbon.

**COMPETITION RULES:**

- All current Swim/National Canada (SNC) rules will apply
- Sanctioned by Swim Ontario.
- Please note that Swimming Canada Competition Warm-Up Safety Procedures will be in effect. Swimmers witnessed by a Safety Marshal diving or entering the water in a dangerous fashion may be removed without warning from their first individual event following the warm-up period in which the violation occurred.
