Our young swimmers achieve excellence while pursuing the dream of competing for Canada. Involvement in HAC requires a level of commitment and training above what is normally experienced in recreational programs. There is increased emphasis on technical development, time in the pool and family involvement. The benefits include enhanced self-esteem, an appreciation of teamwork, time management and the enjoyment of being involved in a healthy, active life style with a good circle of friends.

The successful operation of HAC depends on the active involvement of our member families in club swimming and fundraising events. It takes the co-operative efforts of family members to keep fees as low as possible and to ensure the safety and enjoyment of our athletes. HAC is looking forward to another great season! This new system is fast and easy and will aide our coaches and HAC Administration in providing the best possible programming to meet the individual needs of our swimmers. Payment information will be submitted separately.

Team Uniforms

For the 2016/2017 Swim Season HAC will be moving towards a mandatory uniform for swim meets. All swimmers will be required to wear a HAC Swim Cap and HAC T-Shirt when on deck and swimming in a swim meet. T-Shirts are \$14 to \$20.00 and Personalized Caps are \$32.00. An order form is attached with this package. **There is no need to order items if your swimmer already has a cap and a t-shirt.**

Volunteering

Each family will be asked to volunteer a set number of swim meet sessions (depending on level) during the year. Any representative from your family is able to participate and earn your volunteer points provided he/she is over the age of 14. More than one family representative may work any swim meet at the same time. Each session worked earns one point. A full point value chart indicating other ways to earn points will be presented at the Annual General Meeting in September. Bond cheques will be cashed on May 31, 2017 if less than 50% of the participation requirement has been met. Any adjustments for participation done after May 31 will be handled before June 30th. If a family has only partially completed their volunteer requirement there will be a pro-rated levy applied. Failure to show for an agreed upon session will result in a \$60.00 assessment.

We will be kicking off the 86th season of Hamilton Aquatic Club the week of September 12, 2017. Stay tuned to the website and note that a modified pool schedule will most likely be in effect the first two weeks of practice as some of the pools we utilize may be shut down for maintenance.
