Our alumni includes three-time Olympian, **Joanne Malar** and 2 time Olympian **Scott Dickens**, as well as coaches, parent volunteers and officials recognized by provincial and national swimming associations.

The Hamilton Aquatic Club is dedicated to the development of young swimmers to their highest potential while pursuing and achieving their personal goals and developing self-discipline, sportsmanship and leadership. Our young swimmers achieve excellence while pursuing the dream of competing for Canada. Involvement in HAC requires a level of commitment and training above what is normally experienced in recreational programs. There is increased emphasis on technical development, time in the pool and family involvement. The benefits include enhanced self-esteem, an appreciation of teamwork, time management and the enjoyment of being involved in a healthy, active life style with a good circle of friends.

The successful operation of HAC depends on the active involvement of our member families in club swimming and fundraising events. It takes the co-operative efforts of family members to keep fees as low as possible and to ensure the safety and enjoyment of our athletes. HAC is looking forward to another great season! And we want you to be a part of it! Below is everything you need to know to register your child.

Changes for the 2017/2018 HAC Season

We are going paperless for 2017/2018. From registration to clothing orders, 95% of your club transactions will be done by e-transfer or direct withdrawals. There are no more paper waiver forms either! Everything will be done on-line with the exception of your initial direct withdrawal form.

Online Registration

This new system is fast and easy and aides our coaches and HAC Administration in providing the best possible programming to meet the needs of our swimmers. Volunteering

Each family will be asked to volunteer a set number of swim meet sessions (depending on level) during the year. Any representative from your family is able to earn your volunteer points provided he/she is over the age of 14. More than one family representative may work any swim meet at the same time. Each session worked earns one point. A full point value chart indicating other ways to earn points will be presented at the Annual General Meeting in September. Failure to show for an agreed upon session will result in a \$60.00 assessment.

2017/2018 Swim Meet Schedule

New to 2017/2018 swim season, Novice 3 will be taking part in our competitive level home meets (at McMaster). This change will benefit all of our novice; our more experienced Novice 3 racers will expand their experience at the next level meets; and allows the focus at our "novice" circuit meets to be on our new/less experienced racers. The competitive meets do involve a fee (as noted in the individual meet packages but are typically around \$10 per race). To simplify administration and handling of meet fees, an annual meet fee is determined and included in your total fees. Actual meet fees are tracked during the season and any balance will be credited or owed at the end of the season.

We are also happy to welcome Cambridge Aqua Jets to our novice swim meet circuit. Our Novice 2 will now be able to participate in 6 meets during the season plus the Novice Finale (for all novice).

Team Uniforms

For the 2017/2018 Swim Season HAC has a mandatory uniform for swim meets. All swimmers are required to wear a HAC Swim Cap and HAC T-Shirt when on deck and swimming in a swim meet. T-Shirts are \$14 to \$25.00 and personalized Caps are \$35.00. An electronic order form will be sent to you over the summer.
