SANCTION: Approval provided by Swim Ontario. The only meet package which will be considered as valid must be the most current version found on www.swimming.ca

WARM UPS: 4:30 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.

START TIME: 5:20 p.m. (expected end time is approximately 9:30 p.m.)

ELIGIBILITY: Novice, Pre-competitive level swimmers working towards Regional times.

NOTE: Pre-competitive swimmers must be registered with Swim Ontario and will swim as exhibition only; such swimmers are limited to compete once during a swim season per Swim Ontario guidelines.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS:

Each swimmer is limited to one distance per stroke and a maximum of **4 events** plus a relay if time permits. Entries limited to swimmers that have not achieved a Provincial Level C time in the requested event. Meet management reserves the right to limit entries at their discretion to comply with Club policies and in order to balance the loading of the sessions and ensure a successful completion of the meet in accordance with the Swim Ontario mandated timelines.

MIXED-RELAYS:

A mixed relay must have 2 girls and 2 boys. No other combination is allowed. The first leg of a relay is not an official time. Requests for official splits are not allowed for mixed relays.

ENTRY FEES:

For Oakville and Hamilton swimmers: \$7.00 per swimmer.

Other attending clubs' fees are: \$12.00 per swimmer

Cheques should be made payable to Hamilton Aquatic Club.

ENTRIES:

- Entries must be submitted via the online entry system through www.swimming.ca
- Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the meet manager.
- Dates of birth and valid SNC numbers are mandatory for each swimmer.
- Receipt confirmation of your entries will be sent via e-mail.

ENTRY DEADLINES: Entries must be received by **Sunday, April 29th, 2018**. Entries received after this date will still be accepted at the discretion of the meet manager. The scratch deadline is **Thursday May 3rd, 2018**. There is no additional penalty for scratching after the deadline, but entry fees are still due for the swimmers that scratch after the deadline.

AGE GROUPINGS:

BOYS: 8&Under, 9&10, 11&12, 13&Over.

GIRLS: 8&Under, 9&10, 11&12, 13&Over.

Age for this competition is based on age as of the first day of competition.

MEET RESULTS: Results will be posted within 48 hours to the www.swimming.ca website.

MEET AWARDS: Best Time Ribbons will be given to each swimmer for each event where a new best time is achieved. A "NT" entry with a finish time will receive a best time ribbon.

TIME SPLITS:

Meet management requires that any coach wishing to rely on a time achieved by the swimmer for an interval shorter than the total distance of the event shall so advise the Referee prior to the commencement of the session (or event) in question.

SAFETY & LIABILITY:

Only participating swimmers, officials, certified registered coaches, and authorized people are allowed on deck.

RECORDING OF AN EVENT:

Only individuals that have made application and received authorization to record the event, in any manner, in any medium or context known or unknown or hereafter developed, shall be granted access and permission to do so. Please contact meet management for application and authorization.

COACHES REGISTRATION:

Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches in attendance at this competition with the Swim Ontario Compliancy list. If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the SNC policy and not permit that coach to attend the meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.

COMPETITION RULES:

Sanctioned by Swim Ontario. All current Swimming/Natation Canada (SNC) rules will be followed. Please note that Swimming Canada Competition Warm-Up Safety Procedures will be in effect. For club and provincial meets, a swimsuit that covers more of the body such as modesty swimwear or religious cover-ups is permitted providing that the fabric is permeable open mesh textile material and does not give the swimmer an advantage.
