- DATE:** Saturday, July 7 - Sunday, July 8, 2018
- HOSTED BY:** Burlington Aquatic Devilrays
- LOCATION:** Nelson pool – 4235 New Street Burlington, Ontario
- FACILITY:** Eight lane, 50 meter outdoor tank, with lane markers.
Colorado Timing System.
- MEET FORMAT:** All Events will be timed finals. All sessions limited to 4.5 hours maximum.
All events will be swum slowest to fastest by submitted entry times.
Individual events will be senior seeded by gender and awards given by age classification.
- MEET PACKAGE:** The only meet package which will be considered as valid must be the most current version found on www.swimming.ca

- Officials registered with Swim Canada are invited to assist at the meet. If anyone is interested in officiating, please send an email to the Officials Chair. Please advise if an evaluation is requested and/or if a specific position is preferred. Refreshments will be provided to all officials working at the meet.
- COMPETITION RULES:** Sanctioned by Swim Ontario.
All current Swimming/Natation Canada (SNC) rules will be followed.
- Please note that Swimming Canada Competition Warm-Up Safety Procedures will be in effect. The full document can be viewed [HERE](#).
- For club and provincial meets, a swimsuit that covers more of the body such as modesty swimwear or religious cover-ups is permitted providing that the fabric is permeable open mesh textile material and does not give the swimmer an advantage. The full interpretation can be viewed [HERE](#). Advanced notification or for clarification of interpretation please see the Competition Coordinator.
- AGE UP DATE:** Age determined as of the first day of meet, Saturday, July 7, 2018.
- ELIGIBILITY:** All athletes must be registered as Competitive Swimmers with SNC, or any other amateur swimming organization recognized by FINA. A valid SNC registration number is required for all Canadian swimmers, and entries without a SNC registration number will be declined entry.

ENTRY FEES: \$12.00 per swimmer per individual event
\$18.00 per team per relay event.
\$2.50 per Swimmer Splash Fee.

Entry fees are processed based on entries submitted by the entry deadline, regardless of whether the swimmer competes or not.

DE-QUALIFYING TIMES:** There are no qualifying time standards to swim in this competition.

ENTRIES: Participation of this meet is at the full discretion of the host club and participants of past meets by the host club will be given priority.

Entries are not considered accepted until confirmed by meet management.

All entries must be in Hy-tek format and be submitted through the SNC online entries system at www.swimming.ca. Meet Management will not accept entries directly via any other means.

Maximum of 4 (four) events per swimmer per session not including relays

Please include appropriate Long Course (in meters) entry times - Short Course times should be converted into Long Course times using Hy-tek default conversion factor.

"NT" entries WILL NOT be accepted.

Each swimmer's entries are limited as follows:

- 400 IM event - 16 fastest female and 16 fastest male swimmers
- 400 Free event - 16 fastest female and 16 fastest male swimmers

ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday, June 22, 2018 at 6pm
Confirmation of entries receipt will be sent. Please ensure these entries are correct and immediately contact the Meet Manager with any problems.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries may be accepted as Exhibition Swims Only in empty lanes only, at the discretion of the meet manager

DECK ENTRY FEES: \$15.00 per swimmer per individual event for all events.
\$20.00 per team per relay team.
Payable at the time of the request.

SCRATCH RULES: Scratch deadline is 30 minutes prior to the start of the affected session. There will be no penalties (or refunds) for scratches or no shows.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to the top three swimmers in each event as outlined below.

Age groups for awarding medals will be as follows:

Individual Events:

Girls: 10& Under, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & over.

Boys: 10& Under, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & over.

Relay Events

Girls: 12 & Under, 13 & Over

Boys: 12 & Under, 13 & Over

Bell Prizes will be awarded to heat winners randomly throughout the meet.

MANAGEMENT ITEMS: Meet Management reserves the right limit entries to any event, session, or the meet. Meet Management reserves the right to modify session times and event limits or times as necessary to accommodate meet requirements and will notify coaches whenever possible.

Sprint lanes will be available for the last 20 minutes of warm-ups. Lanes 7 and 8 will be used for Sprinting and are designated as diving lanes with one-way traffic only. Lane 1 will be a pace lane for the last 30 minutes of the warm up.

There are capacity restrictions and limited spectator seating at this facility. People not directly involved in the current session may be asked to leave the fenced-in area.

This is an outdoor swim meet. In the event of thunder, lightning or severe weather there may be delays or interruptions to the meet and possibly cancellation of some or all events.

Meet officials will provide a safe environment and an organized competition. We are not responsible for the supervision of the athletes during the competition or during session breaks.

CANCELLATIONS: In the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the Burlington Aquatic Devilrays, (for example but not limited to; weather interruptions or facility malfunctions) that force the cancellation of all or part of the meet, a partial refund may be granted at the discretion of the Meet Manager.

COACH'S

REGISTRATION:

Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches in attendance at this competition with the [Swim Ontario Compliancy lists](#). If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the SNC policy and not permit that coach to attend meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.

OFFICIAL SPLITS:

The procedure for obtaining an 'Official Split' now requires that coaches make the request to the session Referee or Meet Management on a time card (provided by the Meet Office) prior to the race. The split for the lead-off leg in relays will still be regarded as an official split and therefore no request by coaches is needed for relays.

Meet Management requires that any coach wishing to rely on a time achieved by the swimmer for an interval shorter than the total distance of the event shall so advise the Referee prior to the commencement of the session (or event) in question.

MEET RESULTS:

Results will be posted on the BAD website www.burlingtondevilrays.ca – Look for the Live Results link and uploaded to www.swimming.ca within 48 hours of the completion of the meet. Connectivity Permitting, unofficial results will also be posted to Meet Mobile following each event.

RECORDING OF THE MEET:

Only individuals who have made application and received authorization, in advance, to record the event, in any manner, in any medium or context now known or hereafter developed, shall be granted access and permission to do so. Please contact Meet Manager for application and authorization.

Photographers must obtain authorization from Meet Management before the start of the meet to obtain access to the deck. As outlined in Appendix D

SAFETY AND LIABILITY:

Only participating swimmers, officials, certified registered coaches, and authorized people are allowed on deck. Non-participants of the meet may be asked to move off of the deck to accommodate participants of the meet.

FOREIGN

COMPETITORS:

All swimmers and coaches must be duly registered and residents of the governing body for which they are competing. All swimmers and coaches must be in good standing with their respective governing swim body.

All swimmers and coaches must have primary residence within the province /state or country for which they claim registration. Proof of residency may be green card, student ID, driver's license, college residence or other document as deemed acceptable by Swim Ontario and shall be submitted with the [Proof of Residence and Registration Status form](#) to Swim Ontario no later than 7 days prior to start of competition.

Sun Shelters:

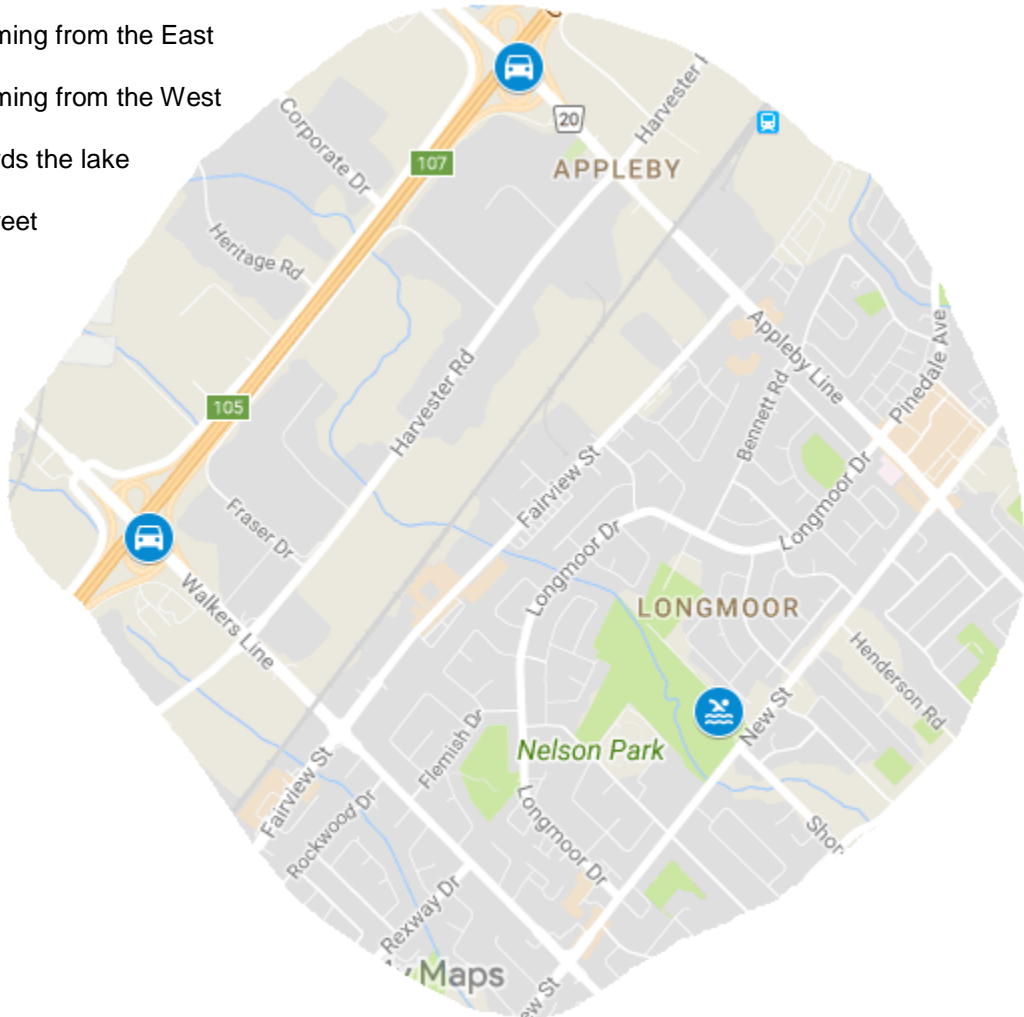
Directions to Pool

Travel South towards the lake

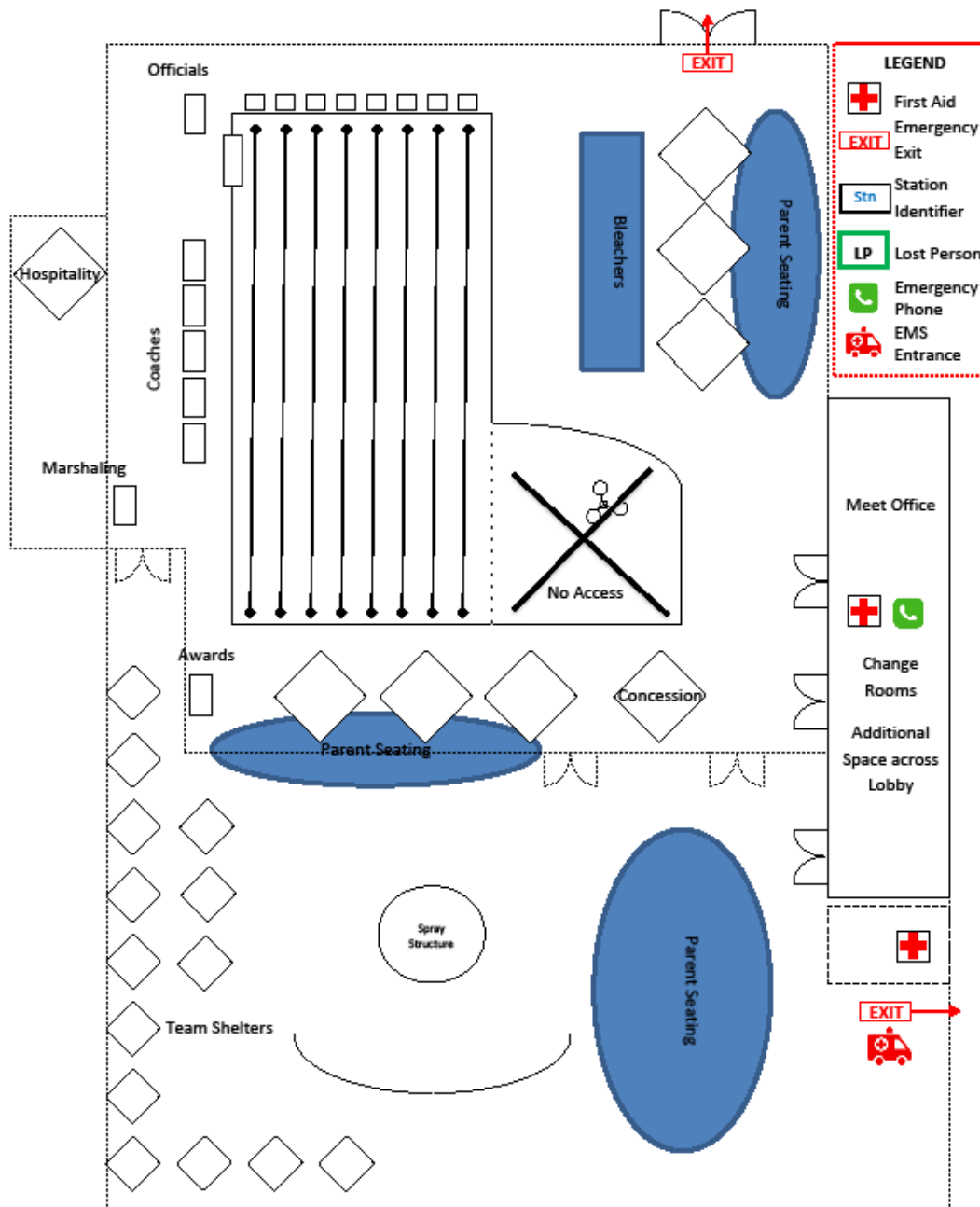
Turn on to New Street



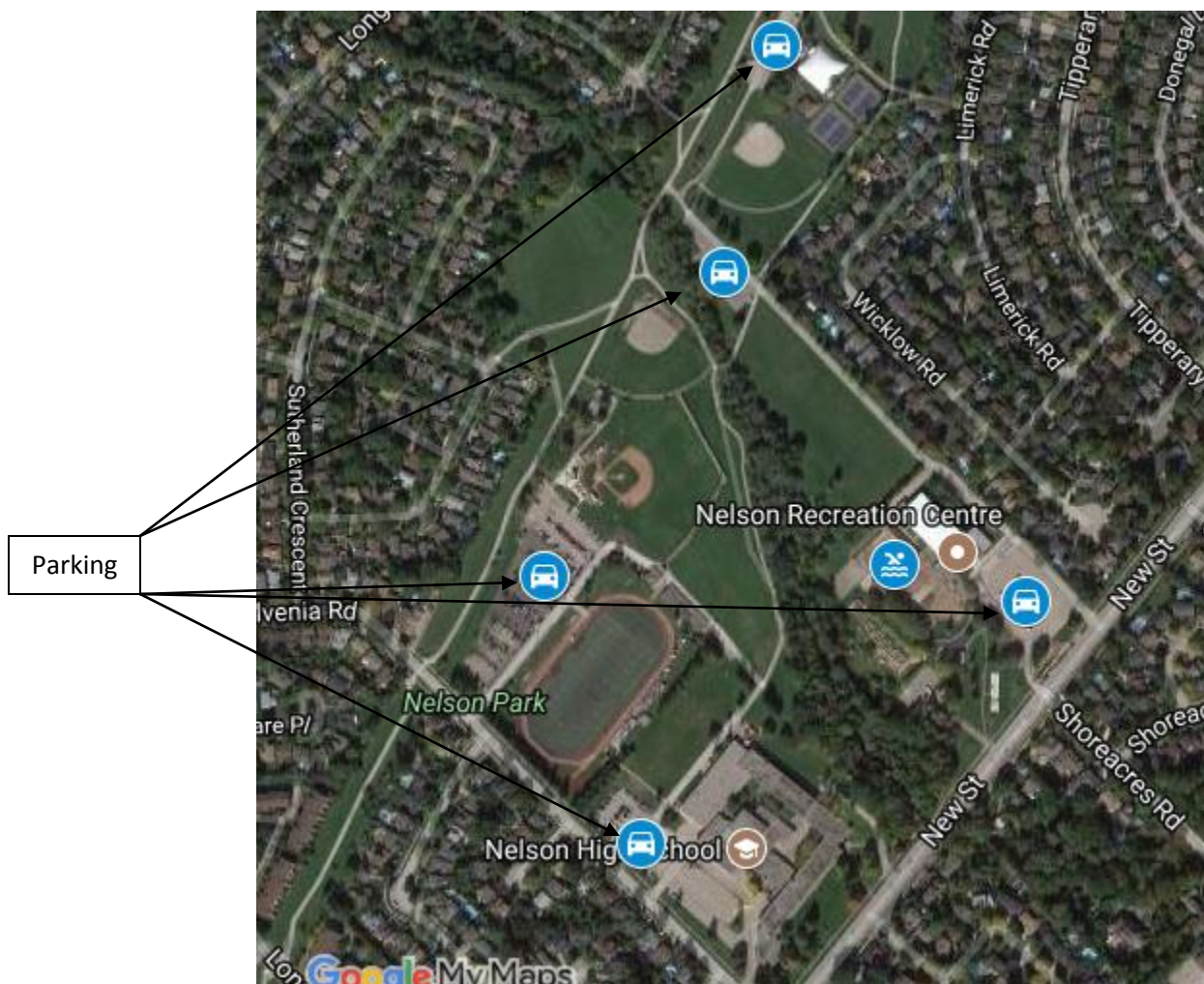

Nelson Pool – – 4325 New Street Burlington, Ontario.

Parking is available at the pool; priority will be given to meet management and coaches for these spaces. Please be considerate of others and provide ample room to get people and cars in and out. There are several lots around the pool that are free. On street parking is at your own risk.

Should no parking spaces be available in the parking lots at Nelson Recreation Center, Nelson Park (north lot), or north of Nelson Stadium. Burlington street parking by-laws allow for personal vehicles to be parked in legally permitted areas for no more than 5 hours. By-law enforcement has been advised of the event and will be proactively patrolling the area to ensure compliance.

There are no lockers at Nelson Pool. There is a children's splash pool area that will be open for the use of family members at some times throughout the meet. Parents are encouraged to bring lawn chairs for seating.
