Meet Information:

These dual HOBB league meets are held with Oakville, Burlington and Hamilton. Each swimmer is limited to one distance per stroke for a maximum of 5 events.

If a swimmer has achieved a Provincial Level C time in any event they are not permitted to swim in that event at future HOBB meets.

These meets are intended to be Novice meets for swimmers working toward Regional times.

SNC rules are in effect including Warm-up procedures, FINA one start rule, and the FINA swim suit policy.
